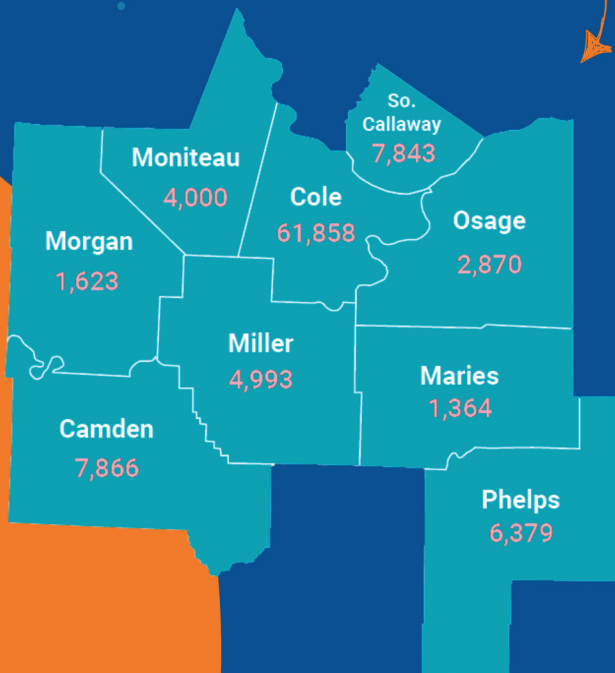


Impact-Driven Initiatives

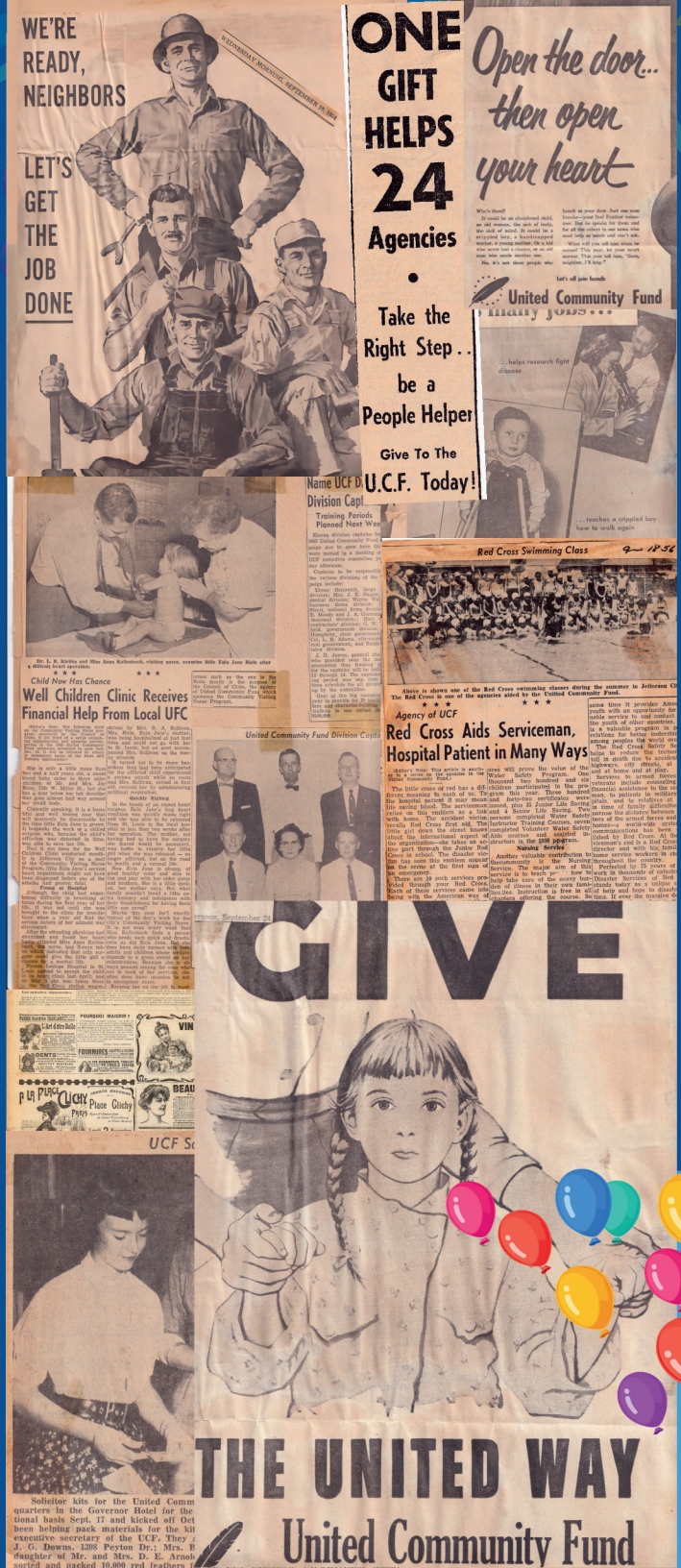

- Partners with schools, shelters, food pantries, healthcare providers, and countless other organizations to create meaningful impact

- In 2024 your donations turned into:
- 23,770 homebound meals delivered to help seniors stay in their homes
 - 100% of children in our quality childcare programs were kindergarten-ready
 - 427 women and children received safe shelter to begin again
 - 239 individuals with disabilities gained access to employment resources, services, or summer camps
 - Over 278,000 pounds of food distributed to more than 22,000 individuals

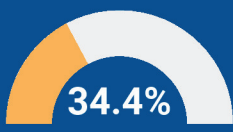
Dollars Raised 2024

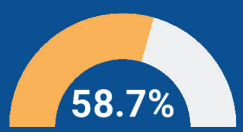
Goal for 2024

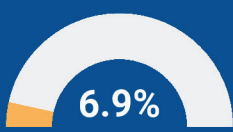
Total amount raised in 2024
